THREE LIFE CHANGING POSSESSIONS (Pt. 1)

I. Our friends can change our lives.

- A. Those of us who have lived for a while know that friends can make or break us.
 - 1. 1 Corinthians 15:33.
 - 2. This is usually a lesson learned through observation of others and also from experience.
- B. The Bible teaches that we need to choose our friends wisely because of the great influence they have with us.
- C. The Bible gives examples of friends being hinderers instead of helpers.
 - 1. Job had three friends that were much more of a hindrance than a help.
 - 2. Amnon, David's son, had a friend that was definitely a hindrance and not a help.
 - a. He gave the advice to Amnon that led to the rape of Tamar.
 - b. Ultimately, it led to the death of Amnon at the hands of Tamar's brother, Absalom.
- D. Leroy Brownlow wrote: "A friends is like a break for a hungry appetite; like a balancing pole for walking the tightrope of life; like a soothing ointment for the cuts an bruises of life; like a golden link in the chain of life; and like a vine that clings to us despite our weaknesses."
- E. Friends, when chosen wisely, can help us through our darkest times.
- F. We all need someone with whom we can confide our desires, hurts and dreams.
- G. There is one who longs to be our friend and that is God.
 - 1. Abraham was called a friend of God (James 2:23).
 - 2. We can be a friend of God if we live a life dedicated to Him as did Abraham (John 15:14).
- H. This friendship is the most important in life and it is a possession we should long to have and greatly desire to keep.
- I. Most of us here have been let down by a friend at some point in life.
 - 1. Friends don't mean to let us down but they do because they are human.
 - 2. If we think back, we can probably think of times we let a friend down
 - 3. We are human as well.
- J. The great thing about our Lord and our heavenly Father is that they will never let us down.
 - 1. God has told us that He will never leave us nor forsake us (Hebrews 13:5).
 - 2. Notice how the Psalmist described God (Psalm 46:1).
- K. The Godhead loves and cares for us deeply.
 - 1. God loved us so much that He sent His Son to die for us (John 3:16)
 - 2. That shows how much God wants to be our Friend.

- L. We need the friendship of people in our lives but most importantly, we need the friendship of God in our lives.
- M. It is a possession to be treasured and protected.

II. Our family can change our lives.

- A. For most people, family is a tremendous possession.
 - 1. There are those who don't get along with their families or have had tragic family events take place.
 - 2. Our hearts ache for those who have experienced such because we know that family should be safe, loving and nurturing.
- B. We should understand that family is important because God ordained the institution of the home in the beginning.
 - 1. Genesis 2:18.
 - 2. We know that God created Eve for Adam and ordained the home at that time.
- C. To Adam and Eve the command was given to multiply (Genesis 1:28).
- D. Families are to be a support system for one another.
 - 1. Spouses are to set the example for their mates and help them get to heaven (1 Peter 3:1-7).
 - 2. Children are to be brought up in the nurture and admonition of the Lord (Ephesians 6:4).
- E. When families are as God would have them to be, there is great joy in the life of the family members.
 - 1. Each has a role to play and when each role is fulfilled there is harmony and peace in the home.
 - 2. God wants husbands/fathers to be the head of the house (Ephesians 5:23).
 - 3. The wife is to submit to the rule of the husband (Ephesians 5:22). Children are to obey their parents (Ephesians 6:1).
 - 4. When these things are taking place as commanded in scripture, the home is as God would have it.
- F. We know that when family life experiences problems that problems will come about in all areas of life.
- G. Most of us look fondly on our families and for good reason.
 - 1. It is with family that most early memories are made.
 - 2. It is from family that we learn how to get along with others.
- H. God wants for the home life to be happy, because He knows it affects all other aspects of life.
- I. It is also important to note that there is a family that is even more important than our physical family.
 - 1. That is the family of God.
 - 2. God wants us to be His spiritual children (Romans 8:14).
 - 3. God has a house and it is the church (1 Timothy 3:15).
 - 4. We are His children when we are in His church.
 - 5. Not only that, we become heirs of God and joint heirs with Christ when we are a part of His church (Romans 8:17).

- J. It may be that our physical families have deserted us or died or, for some other reason, there is separation.
 - 1. Such will never be the case with God and His family.
 - 2. God has promised to never leave us or forsake us (Hebrews 13:5).
 - 3. The church, as a family, will always be there and God as a father and Jesus as an adopted brother will always be there.
- K. God loves us and wants us to be a part of His family.
- L. What an honor it is and would be for each to possess membership in the family of God!
